

Marc Massé will direct the communication that will debate in the international congress Horizons of Billiards on the relation of youth with the billiards of carom and the best way to present our sport to the new generations.

Marc Massé counts on one expanded experience in all the areas of our sport. Marc Massé is at present, the National Technical Director of the French Federation of Billiards from November of 1999. He has had an important participation in the elaboration of programs of learning and training of the Federation since 1995.

Also, and from 1999, he has participated in the development of the structures of welcome and initiation in the clubs and in the elaboration of programs of formation of Entertainers of Clubs, Federal Initiators and Monitors titled of State.

He has obtained, between 1988 and 1998, 23 titles of Champion of France in diverse specialties of caroms and a title of Europe Champion Free in 1993.



Marc has declared with respect to the appointment of the next month of October in Madrid:

“The billiards of Caroms needs a new impulse to integrate itself in the sport activities of nowadays.

The development of the practice, the sport of high level and the mediatización of the discipline must be the center of the preoccupations of all the actors of billiards, players, leaders, clubs and rooms of billiards, industry of the sector, etc.

Therefore, it is necessary to celebrate the initiative of the World Union of Billiards that proposes an international debate about these crucial questions. In this occasion, everyone will be able to become rich of the experience of the other and thus to participate more effectively in the development of our sport in each country.

I make votes so that many testimonies of experiences are contributed to support the interchanges in Madrid and so that this type of encounter renews to register this will of evolution in the time. ”
